During Ohio's State of Emergency due to Covid-19 illness, HCS will be offering a remote learning option to in-district students in grades 6-12 for school year 20/21. As the parent/guardian you will be your child's learning coach. Your child's educational success, a primary goal of HCS, can only be achieved if you understand your key role in following the curricular and attendance requirements below. Parent(s) or Guardian(s) agree to the following:

- My role, which is vital for my child's academic achievement, is valued and respected among administrators, teachers, staff and volunteers at HCS.
- I believe that my student has the ability to grow academically.
- I will abide by HCS's policies and procedures as outline on the enrollment handout.
- **I will maintain continuous internet service** and make sure my student has daily access to participate in courses.
- I understand that the HCS Edmentum program includes 6-12 curriculum, periodic assessments, online instructional tools, specific face-to face- testing requirements, and may require some attendance in the physical building throughout the school year.
- My student is enrolled in a public school and must meet the state attendance requirements. Students in grades 1-12 require a minimum of 920 hours per year. To reach my student's academic goals, average daily attendance may range from 3-8 hours.
- As my child's learning coach, I am responsible to accurately monitor my child's attendance and academic progress. Insufficient hours of attendance or insufficient progress will result in your child being marked absent and the school's attendance policy and procedures will be enacted. In addition, any attendance concerns could result from the removal of the Edmentum Program at the end of the semester and future applications for participation may be denied.
- My child will participate in all required state achievement and diagnostic testing at Hillsboro Middle/High School 550 US RT 62 S, Hillsboro, OH 45133. It is my responsibility to provide transportation to and from the test site. Testing dates will be shared via mail and email with you and your child 2 weeks prior to testing dates.
- I will actively engage with HCS staff by participating in conference, reading email on a daily basis, submit requested assignments, and attend face-to-face activities throughout the year, including state testing, and ETR and IEP meetings (if applicable.) I will work with and treat administrators, teachers, staff, and volunteers professionally, understanding that staff must follow set schedules and policies.
- Failure to follow the school's program requirements may result in my student's removal from Edmentum Courses.
- I understand that HCS is not promoting the Edmentum program but has made this curriculum available during this state of emergency for parents who do not want their child to physically attend HCS daily. HCS does not recommend this curriculum over what is provided in the traditional classroom by highly qualified staff.
