Updated 2021 - 2022 Restart Health Guidelines

Federal, state and local health authorities have issued recommended health protocol guidelines for the start of the 2021-2022 school year. The link for the COVID-19 Health and Prevention Guidance for Ohio K-12 Schools is:

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND:

- All students and staff members wear a face covering when in our facilities or at an event.

WHILE AT SCHOOL:

- We will perform daily temperature checks, if a fever of 100 or more, the student can return to school after being fever free for 48 hours without any medicine.
- Promote proper hand washing throughout the school day.
- Utilize hand sanitizer throughout the school day.

WE REQUIRE DUE TO CDC ORDER FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

- All school personnel and students wear a face covering while on a school bus.

QUARANTINE / CONTACT TRACING REQUIREMENTS:

- Any individual that tests positive or is identified as a close contact will be quarantined for 10 days.
- Any individual that is within 3 feet of a positive case for more than 15 minutes in a 24 hour period will be considered a close contact.

QUARANTINE / CLOSE CONTACT EXEMPTIONS: (ANY ONE OF THE THREE)

- If an individual is 14 days after being fully vaccinated and doesn't have any symptoms.
- If an individual is wearing their mask properly.
- If an individual is further than 3 feet away from a positive case.

These guidelines are subject to change based on changes made by federal, state or local authorities or a health emergency within our district. Going to school safely, in person, five days a week is the expectation.
